What's New


- Start Menu and Taskbar changes.












Layout - Start Menu








Layout - Wifi, Battery, and Sound








Productivity Changes - File Explorer






Software Changes - Outlook

Transition Timeline

Key Milestones

- **February 2025:** New employees receive Windows 11 devices.
- **February 2025:** Faculty and staff in-place upgrades scheduled at the Help Desk.
- May 2025: Classroom computers upgraded to Windows 11.
- October 2025: End of support for Windows 10

How to Get Ready

- Back up files using OneDrive (short demo coming up).
- Ensure all critical updates are installed on current devices by rebooting.

One Drive Overview

What is OneDrive?

Cloud storage solution included with GGC accounts.

Quick Walkthrough

- Signing into OneDrive for the first time.
- Uploading, organizing, and accessing files.
- Making sure files are showing as uploaded.

Why Is Backing Up Important?


- The in-place upgrade process will take longer if data is backed up at the Help Desk.
- Avoid potential data loss
- Bonus: useful as an everyday tool!

Accessing Files

Where Are My Files?

- By default, OneDrive saves files that are stored in the following locations:
 - Desktop
 - Documents
 - Pictures
- OneDrive locations can be changed.
- OneDrive Files are accessible via File Explorer or your browser (https://ggcedumy.sharepoint.com/my).

Setting Up OneDrive




Signing In


- Click on the **blue cloud icon** in your taskbar.
- If you can't find it, click on the small up arrow in the taskbar first.
- Use your GGC credentials to log in.

One Drive Icons

What Does Each Icon Mean?



Only available on OneDrive. You must have an internet connection to access the file.



Available on OneDrive and your hard drive, but the local copy is deleted if you use OneDrive's "free up space" option.



Available on OneDrive and your hard drive. The hard drive copy is permanent until you delete it.
